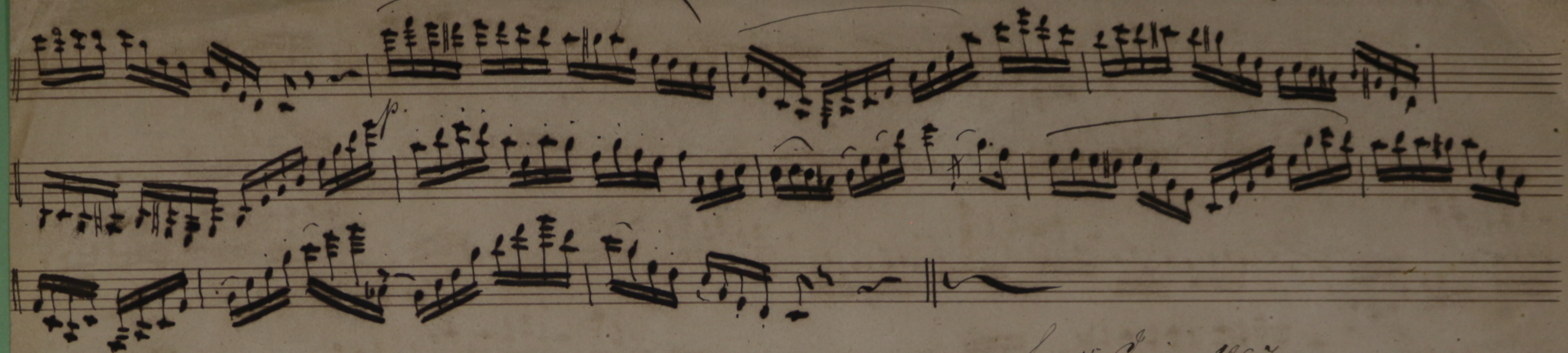


Caprice pour la Clarinette.

Allegro Vivace C
